

Scripps Student and Instructor Dress Code

These guidelines are minimum requirements expected of faculty and students. In addition, certain Scripps facilities may require additional site-specific dress requirements.

- 1. Scripps ID Badge must be worn at all times above waistline.
- 2. If your role requires wearing scrubs, they should be business-like, clean, pressed, free of tears or stains, and of appropriate fit.
- 3. No jeans, low-cut necklines, low-cut backs, or bare/visable midriffs.
- 4. Low-heeled shoes with closed toes. Shoes should be clean and in good condition. Clogs must have a strap around the heels. No sandals or flip-flops.
- 5. Jewelry:
 - Only wedding or simple rings and limited to one per hand No piercings or jewelry/hardware may be evident other than one small stud earring per ear. Facial and tongue piercings are not permitted.
- 6. Hair color must fall within natural occurring shades and be neat. Shoulder length hair or longer must be secured off the face and off the collar. Facial hair must be neatly trimmed.
- 7. Tattoos, when visible, may not display sexual, violent, derogatory images or symbols.
- 8. Fingernails must be trimmed short. Light or clear polish without chips is acceptable. No artificial or acrylic nails or components thereof are permitted.
- 9. Make up is to be worn in moderation.
- 10. No perfumes or scented lotions.
- 11. Undergarments must be worn and should not be visible.
